

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

Regarding the Covid-19 Pandemic

Between the Medina Teachers' Association and the Chief School Officer of the Medina Central School District.

WHEREAS, the Medina Teachers' Association (MTA) and the Board of Education of the Medina Central School District (District) are parties to a Collective Bargaining Agreement (Agreement) for the period of July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the MTA and the District have negotiated procedures establishing and/or modifying terms and conditions of employment related to the Covid-19 pandemic; so


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS AGREED THAT:

1. As a result of the unique and special circumstances related to Special Education instructional delivery and planning time affected by the COVID-19 pandemic, the parties agree the scheduled work day as set by Article XIV shall be temporarily modified regarding practices related to student contact time, however the parties further agree the Special Education instructional delivery and planning time will follow all contractual and IEP mandates or CSE recommendations.
2. Virtual learning will not be an option for students unless it is required by NYS. If it is required the parties agree to meet again to discuss how to carry out those requirements
3. Elementary teachers will be solely responsible for their own grade level classroom with access to their own students for the entire instructional time and will not be required to show videos of the specials or attend specials to help with supervision. They will not be charged with supervising two separate classroom settings during a school day.
4. No more than six assignments will be required for secondary teachers. Librarians at high school will be responsible for normal library duties, not teaching a class or fixing technology.
5. Teachers deemed half-time, and half time teachers on assignment will be responsible for only teaching three periods a day
6. Any technology related communication apps will only be added to personal devices with the permission of the owner. Utilization of the app will remain at the discretion of the individual MTA member.

THAT, this MOA is subject to the approval of the Board of Education, and;

THAT, this agreement relates solely to the circumstances set forth herein and shall not be cited as precedent in any other administrative or judicial forum by either party.


